1. Make sure to visit with Jesus today. Say one of the morning/afternoon prayers you have learned at school. Tell Jesus you love him. Put Jesus in your heart.
2. Sing our song about the "month" we are having here at school. Use sign language. Count the numbers on the calendar and tell an adult what number is today. Make sure all written work is turned in with this signed assignment sheet to be given full credit. Stay Warm!

1. Start your day with prayer. Recite one of the prayers we learned at school. Tell Jesus you love him. Put Jesus into your heart.
2. Sing our song about the "month" we are having at school. Count the numbers on the calendar and say the number for today, yesterday and tomorrow. Take a walk to your window and describe the weather. Share your "feelings".

4. Practice printing your name. Capital letter first, rest lower case. Use crayon. If you can't print your name, have an adult print the letters of your name. You trace each letter. Say each letter out loud as you print it.

6. Print how old you are on a piece of paper. Draw objects to match that number. (1 -1 correspondence).
